

# **Advance Information for Summer 2022 Exams**

Due to the impact of Covid-19 on students' education over the last two years, all exam boards governed by Ofqual were asked to provide students with guidance on the content of exams. Exam boards released this information on Monday 7<sup>th</sup> February 2022.



We have put together a comprehensive list of the specific documents that students, parents, and tutors alike may wish to refer to, in order to check the subject content that is and is not going to be tested in the exams.

#### **Key points:**

- The <u>information provided differs</u> in both content and structure between subjects and between exam boards. For example, some exam boards have used lists while some have used tables; some have chosen to specify the topics that are and are not being tested, while others have only highlighted content that will be tested. Therefore, please ensure you read the wording of the document for your subject and exam board carefully.
- Where you see a \* next to a link, this means <u>no advance information</u> has been provided for the exam boards for these subjects. This is because the syllabus has already been reduced. The link we've given takes you to the syllabus changes that were announced in 2021.
- Where you see two \*\* next to a link, this means you need to select the relevant specification from the dropdown menu on the webpage for the advance information relevant to the student's chosen topics.
- All the advance information documents include a <u>recommendation from the exam boards to</u> <u>cover as much of the syllabus as possible</u>, even though they're highlighting the main areas that will be tested. The reason for this is that, inevitably, some topics can overlap, and in some subjects more than others, higher grades are achieved by having a more comprehensive knowledge of a wider range of concepts. We would recommend that teaching and revision be heavily weighted in favour of the topics listed in the advance information, but where possible, the remaining syllabus topics are also looked at.
- <u>Cambridge Assessment International Education</u> (CAIE) is not governed by Ofqual and is therefore, not obliged to provide advance information. They have chosen not to do so, which is why it is not included below.

It is also important to read the **accompanying crib sheet** carefully for further guidance on advance information.
